Experience Traditions Up Close

These four happen only once a year: The Corpus Christi procession with its festively decorated boats on Lake Hallstatt, the Narcissus Festival on Lake Grundl, the Pasture Drive Festival in October in the middle of St. Wolfgang and "Whistler's Day" on 15 August, held in a place in the Salz-

It's on Tap: Rössl-Peterbräu Beer

Peterbräu – what else should it be called, the golden drink that Stefan Peter once brewed where the Weisses Rössl stands today. Thousands of thirsty pilgrims once promised easy sales. In the end, the descendants of the brew master, who emigrated from Bavaria to St. Wolfgang exactly 300 years ago, had to stop production due to the overwhelming competition from the Salzburg breweries. In cooperation with the Salzburg private brewery Trurmer, we have resurrected Peterbräu in its anniversary year 2011. The anniversary beer will be on tap just in time for the start of the season at the market festival. It is a cellar-darkened Märzen beer, an exceptionally drinkable, strong, typical Austrian beer speciality. During the brewing process, our brew master places special value on classic, open fermentation with home-grown yeast and on the long storage period. A full-bodied, strong bouquet, paired with a spicy, slightly caramel-like note!

New from 8 April: The lake bridge

Preparations for the short period when the Weisses Rössl is closed have been ongoing for many weeks and months. On the Monday after the closing, the first workers stormed the building at 7:00 am. There is something to improve and to repair in every nook and cranny. The working days often last well into the night and include Saturdays. After the much-too-short fortnight, the construction sites and all repair work must be completed.

What was on the programme this year for the time in "dry dock"? An attraction will be added to our spa in the lake: in the future, two floating bathing platforms will connect the lake pool and the whirlpool area. Via the so-called lake bridge, it will now be possible to move between the two heated pools across the water. And the new sunbathing areas with an unimpeded view of the lake and the mountains will delight our bathing guests!

Curious guests may be wondering what is planned for the new lake area between the hotel and the new bathing platform. Well, we have some plans up our sleeves, but we are not able or allowed to reveal them yet ... so in the meantime, this part will be left to our guests' imagination.

A Fresh Shine for the Holiday Flats

The holiday flats in the residence on the lake were subjected to a generous renovation while the hotel was closed, and we look forward to receiving our guests' feedback. As usual, the 300 sq. m. bathing meadow near the building invites guests to sunbathe and swim. Directly adjacent is a small summer bar. Sports enthusiasts come here directly after waterskiing and diving to enjoy some refreshments. The boat rental is also just a few steps away. After the renovation of the flats in the Belvedere Residence over the past year, there are

now eleven flats of various sizes and levels of furnishing. What all eleven units share is the gorgeous view of the lake. In the "Wiesler Horn" flat, you can even enjoy the view directly from the whirlpool

tub! All

day flat guests can use the 1500 sq. m. spa area in the hotel free of charge; in the summer months of July and August, a Rössl sailor chauffeurs our guests staying in the lakeside residence directly to the hotel and back between 10:00 am and 6:00 pm.





Peaceful Wellness, Market Festival & Narcissus Magnificence, (E) Biking & Hiking

This year, Easter Sunday is not until 24 April. Meaning that all eagerly awaited holidays tumble out of the merry month of May and into June. This makes May a peaceful wellness month entirely devoid of holiday hustle and bustle! Summery temperatures are not a rarity during this time, and experience has shown that the first swimmers venture into the lake in May.

New this year is the market festival in the three Lake Wolfgang towns of Strobl, St. Gilgen and St. Wolfgang on Saturday 30 April and Sunday 1 May. At the many stands, finger food delicacies from the Salzkammergut entice. You can get from one place to the other with the boat. Or you can hike – the area around Lake Wolfgang is among the most popular hiking regions in Austria. Whether on mysthic pilgrim's paths, rustic trails way up on the surrounding mountains or cosily on informative themed paths around the lake – the "menu" for hikers is extensive!

Talking of lake hiking: on nearby Lake Grundl, there is a unique spectacle in May. White carpets of blossoms spread out on the meadows all around Lake Altau. A captivating fragrance wafts through the spring air. The time of the Narcissus Festival in the Ausseerland has come. From 2 to 5 June, everything revolves around these white

blossoms! The highlight: during the boat parade in the middle of the lake, imaginative figures made from thousands of narcissus blooms are presented!

In our opinion, the period from April to June is the ideal time for bicycling. Whether a trekking bike, electric bike or mountain bike – we have greatly expanded our bicycle inventory for 2011 and would like to describe two popular trips here in brief:

Hallstatt tour: Take the shuttle bus to the UNESCO world cultural site Hallstatt. From there, cycle for 46.7 km along the beautiful east shore drive of Lake Hallstatt via Obertraun, through Bad Ischl and through Lake Wolfgang Valley back to St. Wolfgang.

Hallein & Salzburg tour: Take the shuttle bus into the picturesque Faistenau to the 1000 year-old linden. From there, make your way through the Strublklamm to Lake Wiestal, continue to Hallein, and from there down the Salzach River until you reach Salzburg (40.5 km). For fit mountain bikers, we recommend the tour around the Schafberg, a sporty challenge in a dreamy landscape!

"The White Horse Inn" at the Lehár Festival

On 16 July, the spruced-up "White Horse Inn" will grace the stage of the Kurhaus Saal in Bad Ischl – as a new production by director Michael Lackner to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Lehár Festival. This is the charming imperial city where Franz Lehár wrote his unforgettable works. This revue-operetta greets its audience with wit, charm and a lot of Austrian humour from the golden 1920s to today.

The "White Horse Inn" is the most famous homage to the Salzkammergut. Erik Charell and Benatzky and Co. composed a musical monument with this work. "I just can't look," says the smitten head waiter Leopold when he has to watch how his beloved Josepha Vogelhuber, the boss of the "White Horse Inn" runs after lawyer Dr. Siedler, who in turn is courting Ottilie, the daughter of his arch-enemy, factory owner Giesecke. And the handsome Sigismund falls for Klärchen, the daughter of Professor Hinzelmann; they too are guests on Lake Wolfgang. But "in the Salzkammergut, you can easily be happy", and thus at the happy ending, "the whole world is still as blue as the sky" ...

Also on the 2011 programme (from 16 July to 4 September) are Franz Lehár's "Paganini", written for the international star tenor Richard Tauber, as well as three chamber evenings in the Lehár Theatre and the new exhibition "Operetta!" (30 July to 28 October 2011). This art form will be presented fro a very short time in the city museum, a mobile pavilion, in the Lehár Museum and in the Trinkhalle.

Delicacies & Culinary Delights in the Autumn

The Rössl wine culinarium

Restaurant chef Thomas Auinger remembers "One of the highlights of the last wine culinarium was surely the appearance of Willi Opitz from Illmitz in Burgenland." Probably because of the history of his "Opitz One", which is considered the best sweet red wine in the world. On the occasion of Bill Clinton's re-election in 1996, Opitz called the White House and suggested that he bring a special edition called "Mr. President" to the office to congratulate Clinton. This actually worked and since then, Bill Clinton has remained loyal to products from the house of Opitz.

This year, as in 2010, the wine culinarium includes the core message "Wine formula 4": 4 Austrian wine experts from 4 vineregions, 4 Rössl sommeliers, 4 courses from Peter Dengg's speciality cuisine, 4 kinds of cheese, followed by a surprise from the pastry chef. And naturally 4 different well-matched wines. The whole thing is spread comfortably over 4 days with a lot of wellness in between.

26 Oct. Austrian sparkling wines/Styria 27 Oct. Rosé wines/Burgenland

28 Oct. Port wines/Lower Austria 29 Oct. Aceto Balsamico/Vienna

A brief overview of the highlights: "Forticus meets Porticus" in the Felsenkeller. Graf Maximilian von Hardegg presents the "successor" to the famous 94 Porticus competing with other wines from Austria and Portugal. Furthermore: Have you tried up to 20 year-old Balsamico as an aperitif? The producers just happen to be state opera tenor Herwig Pecoraro from Klosterneuburg as well as the distillery and vinegar manufactory Gölles in Riegersburg in Styria. Naturally a rosé tasting and Austrian sparkling wine variations will also be included. And professional tips for the correct handling of good wines are provided along the way. As Willi Opitz puts it so appropriately: "Life is (also) too short to drink bad wine".

The third toque

Since the end of last year, we have been allowed to wear a Gault-Millaut toque for the third time: an honour for the entire team and further motivation for the future. Kitchen chef Peter Dengg is already working on innovations for demanding palates new from the spring is (amongst other things) boiled veal haunch combined with a sheatfish filet from Lake Wolfgang and complemented by root vegetables and horseradish cream.

Naturally, trout from Lake Wolfgang must also be on the menu, as must fine coregonus (a fish in the salmon family) and char, for which the our fisherman Nikolaus Höplinger (see picture above) fishes along with his seaworthy dog only at very specific times of year.

Pilgrimage with Rössl Senior Landlord Helmut Peter

"I'm off then!" The more than three million copies of Hape Kerkeling's cult book sold speak for themselves. The fascination with pilgrimages continues to grow. The reason doesn't matter at all. The cult book author was driven to go on one by a health setback. Whether you have a spiritual background or simply enjoy moving, the main thing is that you go. And it doesn't necessarily have to be Santiago de Campostela.

Together with other pilgrim strongholds such as Rome and Santiago de Campostela, St. Wolfgang was amongst the most important pilgrimage destinations in Europe for several centuries. Twenty to sixty thousand pilgrims followed the tracks of St. Wolfgang to his hallowed place in the Pilgrimage Church.

Today, the VIA NOVA from Regensburg to St. Wolfgang is one of the best-known European pilgrimage routes: 300 km long, well-marked and manageable in ten days for the practised. This year, the Rössl's senior landlord will hike a section of the route with guests who are so inclined in three days, from 20-23 October 2011. On the first stage, the Salzburg lake plateau shows its most beautiful side. In approximately 6 hours, the pilgrims will follow hiking and freight paths from Mattsee across Lake Waller and Lake Zeller to Mondsee, from where our taxi will take the tired pilgrims to the Weisses Rössl. The next morning, the route continues from the old cloister church in Mondsee along the imposing Drachenwand, then towards Schafberg along the shore of Lake Mondsee. Over the Scharfling Pass, you will reach the famous Gut Aich Monastery near St. Gilgen. The route then continues directly along the shore of Lake Wolfgang to Fürberg, where a beautiful guesthouse on the lake invites you in. Exhausted pilgrims take the boat to St. Wolfgang; anyone who still has the strength can take on the last incline up to the Falkenstein Pass! The little church

of St. Wolfgang was built there on an old heathen cult site. Inside the chapel is the so-called "crawl-through stone", a sacred stone which was "built over" with the small church in the 17th century. The "crawl-through-stone" remains unchanged today: one crawls, or in common parlance, "slips" through a narrow crevice, in the hope of spiritual cleansing, fertility or the healing of illnesses. Hikers and pilgrims can quench their thirst at the nearby mineral spring. Now it's just one hour to the destination, after 25 km and approximately 6 hours: the Pilgrimage Church of St. Wolfgang, only a few steps away from the Weisses Rössl!

Friday, 21 October: early breakfast, then hike from Mattsee across Lake Waller and Lake Zeller to Mondsee, transfer to St. Wolfgang to the Weisses Rössl, dinner at the Weisses Rössl

Saturday, 22 October: early breakfast, then transfer to Mondsee and hike via Scharfling and the Falkenstein to St. Wolfgang, dinner at the Weisses Rössl

Sunday, 23 October: sleep in, Sunday breakfast with sparkling wine and piano music in the Weisses Rössl, church tour with "old hotelier" Helmut Peter, departure




